She has worked in the areas of quality, process improvement, project management, training, and communications. Lisa holds 4 certifications in change management, is a Six Sigma Black Belt holder, and holds a master's degree in cultural studies, specializing in corporate culture. Her current position is change management manager for Finning Canada where she is responsible for establishing a change management department and providing support to national initiatives. When she is not managing change, Lisa devotes as much time as she can to skiing and diving.
