ASQ International Appoints Alberta's First ASQ Fellow of the Society



Rajeev Chadha, P.Eng. Master Black Belt

"For outstanding contributions to the professional quality movement in Canada, and for meritorious achievements in the application of Lean Six Sigma, quality and continuous improvement technologies in the Canadian mining industry"

On November 03, 2016, the board of directors of ASQ elected Rajeev Chadha a Fellow of the Society in recognition of his significant contributions to quality.

An ASQ Fellow is an individual who has an established record of contributions, both to the quality profession and to the Society. The grade of Fellow is an earned distinction. Rajeev's achievement of this status is a symbol of respect from his colleagues that has been accepted by the highest officers of our organization.

Rajeev is the first Canadian since 2011 to be appointed as an ASQ Fellow, and is the first ever ASQ Fellow from Alberta and Saskatchewan. The Edmonton Section thanks Rajeev for his service to the ASQ community and for his commitment to quality.

Rajeev will be presented with his Fellow pin at the Fellow Luncheon that will be held in conjunction with the 2017 World Conference on Quality and Improvement on April 30th, 2017 in Charlotte, North Carolina.

About Rajeev: Rajeev Chadha is the industrial technology advisor with the National Research Council of Canada (NRC). He received a master's degree in management and systems, and another in process and food engineering as a United Nations UNDP Fellow. Rajeev is the former chair of ASQ (American Society for Quality) Saskatchewan, and has vast experience in Automotive, Manufacturing, Chemical-Biological and Mining industry in Asia and North America.

Rajeev started his career as a bio-conversion process engineer in the pulp and paper industry, and diversified his career working in food, biochemical, and healthcare industrial research. He worked as a Six Sigma CI lead in the mining sector with Mosaic Potash ULC Canada (2009-2013) and served Ontario's automotive industry from 2000 to 2009 with launching several top-rated vehicles. Rajeev is the current chair of ASQ-Mining Division, and has represented Saskatoon Folk-fest & SIA (Saskatchewan Intercultural Association) on their board of directors. Rajeev is also a member of APEGS (Association of Professional Engineers & Geoscientists of Saskatchewan), and his research interests include process improvements, Lean Six Sigma in mining and manufacturing, process control engineering, total quality management, and strategic management.

ASQ Moves to Computer Based Certification Examination

The delivery method for ASQ Certification exams is changing from paper and pencil, to Computer Based Testing. Candidates will take ASQ Certification exams at a Prometric testing facility where the test will be delivered via computer in a Prometric proctored, secure environment.

This move provides a number of benefits:

- the number of annual exam sittings has increased to 6 (up from 2)
- the length between exam rewrites reduced to 2 months (down from 6 months)
- the number of testing locations has increased to 8,000 (up from 350)
- the number of days until candidates receive their results reduced to 0-4 (down from 10)
